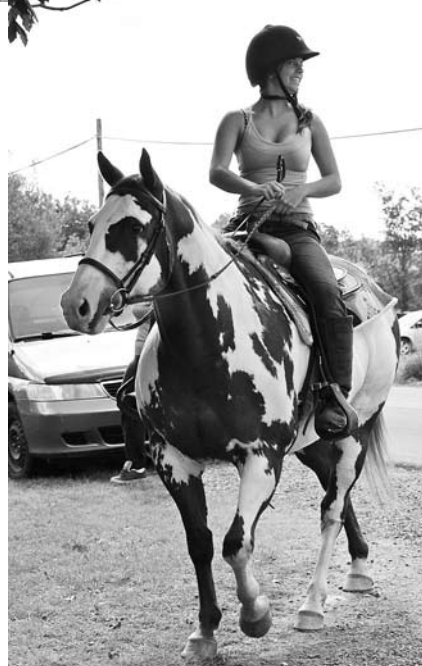
Losing Track of Months :-)

FIELDWOOD PRESENTS TOUR OF BESSIE NORTH HOUSE

In just a few days, you will have a chance to view the historic home of local folk artist and teacher, Bessie North, courtesy of Alan and Barbara North who now own this house and have generously



1886 by Silas Patterson, Ms. North's great grandfather. Patterson was a well-known builder in the area, building houses in Canning, Wolfville and Canard.

It was built on an 80A piece of land and farmed by John A. and Bessie (daughter of Silas) North (1903-1904), Reginald North (1904-1949) and thence to Bessie A. North who sold most of the farm land.

Bessie North was an artist (one of her paintings is shown to the left) and school teacher, fondly remembered

by her pupils, several of whom spoke of her at our 2010 Annual dinner. She was a frequenter of the Canning library and our librarians remember her of being fond of mysteries. North Medford Rd.'s name was changed to Bessie North Rd. in her memory.
