BE IT RESOLVED that the present by-law entitled the Nomination Day By-Law bearing the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs dated September 17, 1985 be repealed and the following by-law be and is hereby approved as the Nomination Day By-Law for the Village of Canning and that same be forwarded to the Minister of Municipal Affairs with the request that he approve of same.

### NOMINATION DAY BY-LAW

1. This By-Law shall be entitled "The Nomination Day By-Law"
2. In this by-law:
  - (a) "Act" means the Municipal Government Act, 1998, c. 18, s. 1;
  - (b) "Village" means the Village of Canning, Kings County, Nova Scotia;
  - (c) "Commissioner or Commissioners" means commissioner or commissioners for the Village within the meaning of the Act;
  - (d) "Clerk" means the clerk and treasurer appointed by the commissioners pursuant to the Act;
  - (e) "Nomination Day" means the second Wednesday preceding election day;
  - (f) "Election Day" means the day the commissioners are elected to office being in June of each year and such other day as may be designated by the commissioners pursuant to Part 18 Section 410 Subsection (1) of the Act;
  - (g) "Candidate" means:
    - (i) A person who, before the close of nominations on nomination day, is declared by himself, or others with his consent, to be a candidate, or
    - (ii) A person, who, after the close of nominations on nomination day, has been nominated as a candidate.
3. No person shall be eligible for election to the office of commissioner or the Village unless that person has been nominated as a candidate in accordance with this by-law by not less than five persons who, on nomination day, were residents within the Village and were qualified electors within the meaning of the Municipal Elections Act, R.S., c. 300, s. 1..
4. All nominations for the office of Commissioner shall be in writing, in Form "A" in the schedule attached to this by-law, and shall be filed with the clerk at the Village office on nomination day and no other day, between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and one o'clock in the afternoon.
5. No nomination shall be valid or shall be accepted by the Clerk unless it has been completed and is signed by the candidate.
6. Only those persons duly nominated in accordance herewith shall appear on the ballots as candidates for election on Election Day. A candidate may only be elected to one office of commissioner on Election Day and upon being declared elected pursuant to the Act, is not eligible for election until his term expires or he has resigned his office.
7. This by-law is made pursuant to the provisions of Section 410 of the Act.
